Buying tickets is a two step process: “**Order Tickets**” and “**Purchase Tickets**” (see buttons below). To purchase tickets online, select “**Luau – 2022 St. Michael’s Fundraiser**” from the drop down menu. You can also purchase tickets with a check or cash. Drop your checks and cash off in the office, put it in the plate on Sunday, or mail them. Please include a copy of your completed Ticket Order Form or a note indicating that your ticket form was completed online and that your cash or check is for the Luau 2022 and the number of tickets. **All Tickets must be ordered and purchased by October 21st.**

The evening will start at 6 pm with cocktails and a silent auction. During the evening, you will have a chance to win a quality bottle of wine at the Duck Pond and enter the 50/50 raffle. Winning ticket receives half of the proceeds with the other half donated to the fundraiser. Reverend Mary will drive the Fund-the-Need Call.

Bella Bru will cater our Luau Feast and there will be a vegan/vegetarian option (marinated portobello mushroom steak with roasted vegetable, quinoa and tomato basil sauce).
