Vestry and Diocesan Delegates are administrative and governing ministries of the Church. ELIGIILITY (as in the diocesan Canons)

Be a member and communicant in good standing for at least 6 months who regularly attends Sunday worship services and is a pledging member or giver of record.

ADDITIONAL QUALITIES DESIRABLE IN CANDIDATES

- Have a commitment to know and love Jesus Christ and follow his ways
- Seek the Holy Spirit's guidance in deliberations and decisions, and
- Be active in the life of the parish and support the mission and ministry of St. Michael's Church.

DUTIES OF VESTRY MEMBERS

Strategically lead the parish to be a relevant place where we are the people of God who live in a meaningful way by worshiping God together, helping those in need and caring for each other. We meet regularly to discuss and maintain strategic goals that help the members of the church grow and spread the gospel to those who have not experienced it yet. Expectations:

- Regular attendance at meetings, attend a yearly scheduled vestry retreat. Meetings are scheduled for the fourth Monday of the Month. Some months require rescheduling.
- Oversee the direction of the church and guide it strategically with the rector, and
- Fiscal responsibility of the parish.

DUTIES OF DELEGATES

• Attend the Spring (May) & Fall (September or October) Convocations and the Annual Convention of the Diocese of Northern California – planned for Friday & Saturday, November 7 & 8, 2025 in Redding CA.
