THE LESSON & PSALM

A reading from the Proverbs (8:1-4, 22-31)

Does not wisdom call,

and does not understanding raise her voice?

On the heights, beside the way,

at the crossroads she takes her stand;

beside the gates in front of the town,

at the entrance of the portals she cries out:

"To you, O people, I call,

and my cry is to all that live.

The Lord created me at the beginning of his work, the first of his acts of long ago.

Ages ago I was set up,

at the first, before the beginning of the earth.

When there were no depths I was brought forth, when there were no springs abounding with water.

Before the mountains had been shaped, before the hills, I was brought forth-when he had not yet made earth and fields, or the world's first bits of soil.

We especially pray for Mary, our retiring head of school and Christine, our incoming head of school, for all the staff, teachers and students at St. Michael's Day School and Starr King TK-8. Lord in your mercy, hear our prayer.

God of peace, bring an end to all wars, freedom for the oppressed, food for the hungry, and safety for the endangered. Lord in your mercy, hear our prayer.

God of love, open us to perceive the joys and sufferings in our midst that we may celebrate with and share the tears of our neighbors. Lord in your mercy, hear our prayer.

God almighty, give strength to those who fear, stand with those who are alone, bring healing to those afflicted, and hope to those who are hopeless. Especially we pray for Jon, Dave, Dancy, Tom, Cindy, Greg, Sarah, Jennifer, Michael, Andrea, Kathy, Chris, Kate, Holly, Frances, Cynthia, Liz, Barbara, Mike, Tina, Mark, Mary, Kay, Hunter, and Billie. Lord in your mercy, hear our prayer.

God eternal, hold in your care all those who have died and grant that they and we may one day rise on the day of new Creation. Lord in your mercy, **hear our prayer.**

For what else or whom else shall we pray? (A time of silence is kept.) Lord in your mercy, hear our prayer.

Gracious God, we give thanks for all the blessings of this life, and especially for the gift of the paternal influences that enrich our lives, teach us wisdom, guide and direct us to mercy and justice, give us the confidence to live into what it is you have planned for us to do, and demonstrate to us fatherly love. We pray that you bless all fathers today and help them to live ever more like You, our one true Father in heaven. **Amen.**

Officiant Grant, O God, that your holy and life-giving Spirit may so move every human heart, and especially the hearts of the people of this land, that barriers which divide us may crumble, suspicions disappear, and hatreds cease; that our divisions being
